

**SENATE BILL 93-06**  
**JUNE 7, 1993**

**TITLE:           REGULATION OF PROFESSIONAL ADVANCEMENT TRAVEL  
GRANT FUNDING FOR REQUIRED ACADEMIC ACTIVITIES**

WHEREAS,       The intent of the Professional Advancement Grant (PAG) is to encourage opportunities beyond those required for completion of one's program of study (POS), and

WHEREAS,       There is currently potential for expenses related to attending required academic activities to be funded by PAG travel grants, and

WHEREAS,       Herein a required academic activity is defined as a class or club recognized by the University, or any course, workshop, class, or other event required for fulfillment of a student's degree requirements or POS, and

WHEREAS,       There is currently no policy addressing such situations, and

WHEREAS,       There has been inconsistent interpretation of PAG policy by past PAG committees, **BE IT THEREFORE**

ENACTED,       That PAG will not fund any expenses for travel to a required academic activity, and **BE IT FURTHER**

ENACTED,       That the PAG committee reserves the right to require applicants to defend, in person or writing, their funding requests.
