

**SENATE BILL S03-05**  
**April 28, 2003**

TITLE: GSS Name Change

WHEREAS: The Graduate Student Senate represents both graduate and professional students at Iowa State University, and

WHEREAS: Iowa State University considers and classifies graduate and professional students separately, and

WHEREAS: The Graduate Student Senate participates in a national organization that represents both graduate and professional students and recognizes so in their name (NAGPS), and

WHEREAS: The current name of the GSS does not adequately reflect the entire constituency, be it therefore

ENACTED: That the name of the GSS shall be changed to the Graduate and Professional Student Senate (GPSS), and be it further

ENACTED: That the GSS Constitution, By-Laws, and Standing Rules shall be amended such that the phrases "Graduate Student Senate" and "GSS" are replaced with "Graduate and Professional Student Senate" and "GPSS," respectively, in each and every instance in which they occur, and be it further

ENACTED: That the Executive Council is authorized to continue making use of existing expendable office supplies bearing the names "GSS" or "Graduate Student Senate," and be it further

ENACTED: That copies of this bill be sent to Dr. Gregory Geoffrey, ISU President; Dr. Thomas Hill, Director of Student Affairs; Dr. Peter Englin, Dean of Students; Dr. James Bloedel, Dean of the Graduate College, Dr. Kathleen Jones, Registrar; Dr. Norman Cheville, Dean of the Veterinary College; Amy Anderson, President of SCAVMA, and Mike Banaziak, President of GSB.
