

SENATE BILL S05-01
January 31, 2005

- TITLE: Restructuring GPSS President and Vice President Positions
- WHEREAS: Effective at the end of Spring Semester 2005, the Graduate and Professional Student Senate (GPSS) Parliamentarian position will be eliminated according to SB F04-04, *Restructuring GPSS Executive Board Positions*, and
- WHEREAS: The duties of the Parliamentarian will be distributed among the Vice President and the Communications Chair, and
- WHEREAS: In the past, it has not always been clear how the duties of running the Senate meetings are divided between President and Parliamentarian, which has occasionally led to confusion during the meetings, and
- WHEREAS: Having the Vice President preside over Senate meetings and the President preside over Executive Council meetings maintains the separation of power currently in place, be it therefore
- ENACTED: That the duties in the current version of the GPSS Constitution and By-Laws be redistributed as listed in the appended Constitution and By-Laws.
