- TITLE: Supporting Recreation Renovation
- WHEREAS: Certain facilities operated by Recreation Services are outdated and in dire need of repair, and
- WHEREAS: The proposed student fee increase would provide necessary funds to update these facilities including historic State Gym, and
- WHEREAS: Exercise, fitness, and good health are essential to the high quality of life for the student population of Iowa State University, and
- WHEREAS: The students of Iowa State University have cited a need for additional recreation space in the feasibility study in February of 2007, and
- WHEREAS: Improved safety and quality of recreation facilities are imperative to providing adequate recreation services and meeting the recreational needs of the student body, be it therefore
- RESOLVED: That the Graduate & Professional Student Senate of Iowa State University support the Extreme Makeover: Recreation Renovation Project proposal by the Iowa State University Department of Recreation Services and encourage students to educate themselves on the issue and vote on the Recreation Services Referendum on February 25th-27th, and be it further
